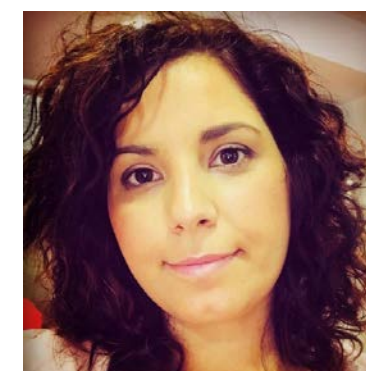

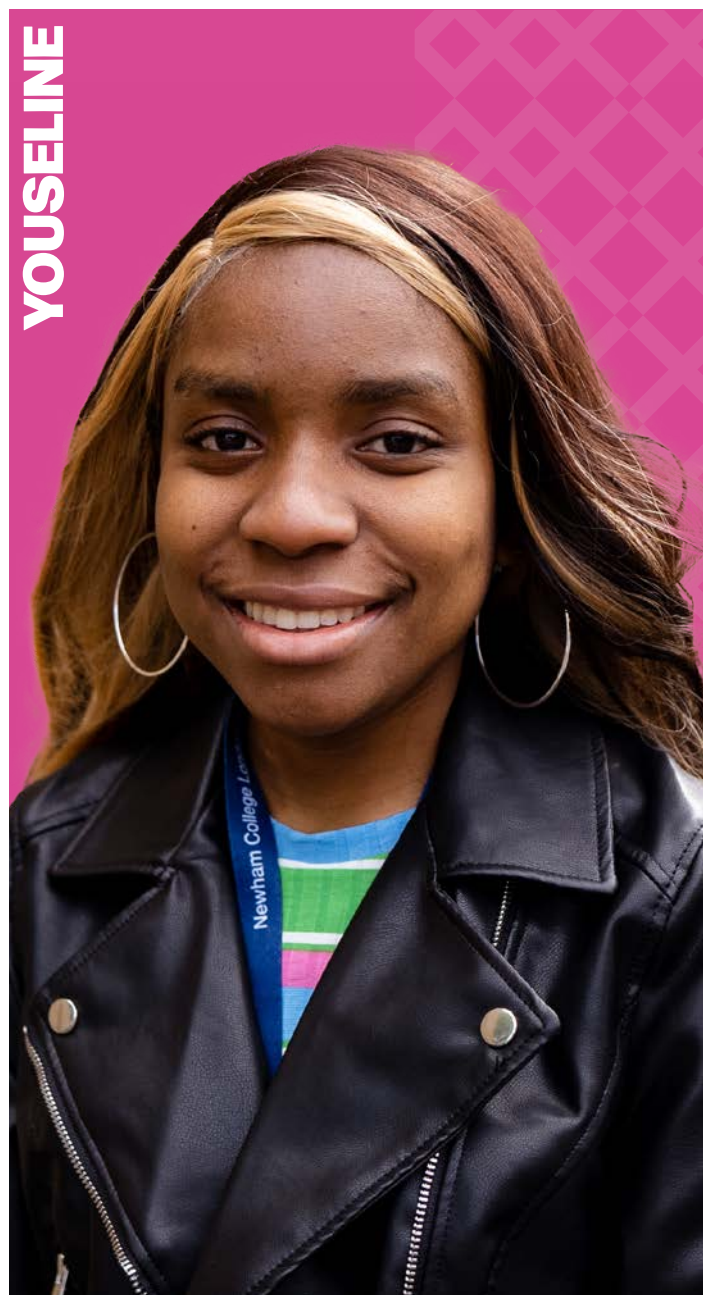

Shirley Joseph is an inspiration to all those who believe that age is a barrier to learning. After forty years in the travel industry, she was determined that redundancy would not end her career. At the age of 59, she became the eldest student in her class to complete the four months of study for an NVQ qualification in track engineering.

Shirley's determination to succeed is a testament to her hard work and the support she received from Newham College. The college's emphasis on strong tutor mentoring helped her to absorb complex briefings, overcome fears, and succeed in the constant testing required to complete her course.

The career progression pathway at Newham College included a visit by Network Rail. They were looking to build a team, and Shirley was fast-tracked into the system. She is now working for the Network Vegetation Team, part of Transport for London. She is ready to take on further education if it helps her new career.

Shirley's journey is an inspiration to all those who believe that age is a barrier to learning. She began working straight after leaving school, and Newham College was her first student life experience.

She did not consider being the only female on her course as a disadvantage and described her younger male colleagues as 'amazing and inspiring'. She regularly hears passengers on Network Rail comment on "how unusual it is to see a female engineer on the tracks!"

Overall, Shirley values the variety of work and quality of training offered on her course. Learning to use new equipment gave her the confidence that she now needs for her job.

Her journey as an adult learner approaching 60 inspires others who find themselves in a similar position as hers not to let redundancy end their working life. She hopes they keep going and growing on their own terms like her.

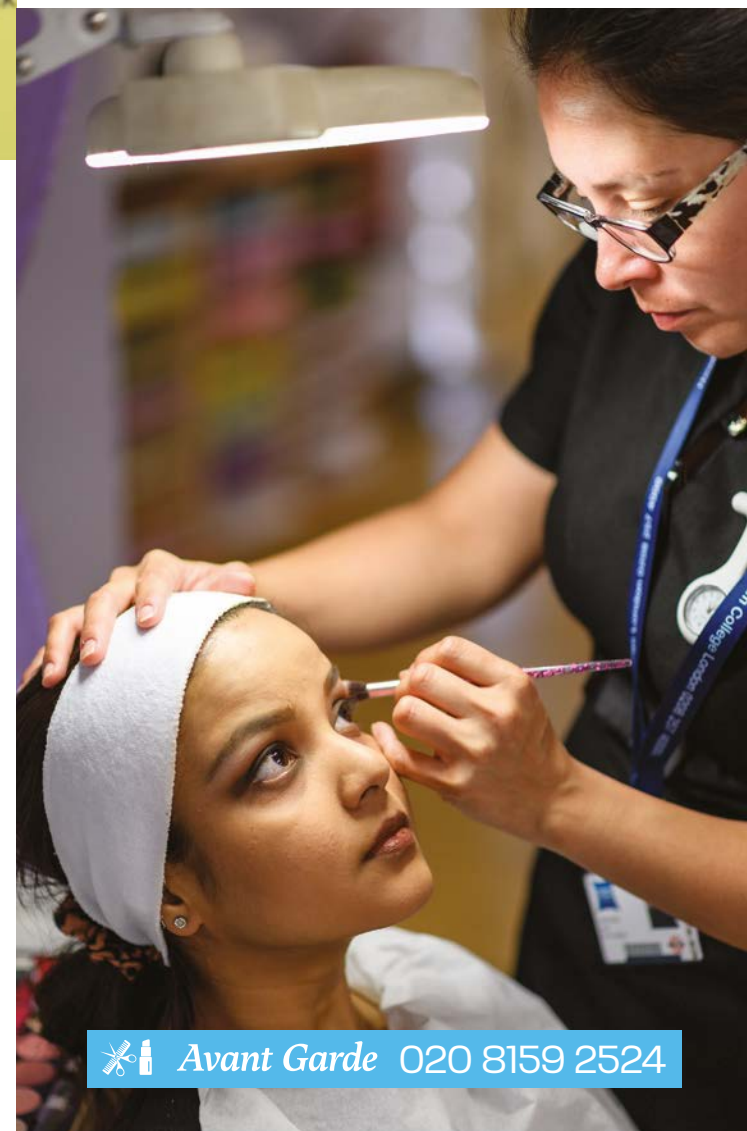

Mario Iokam is a Newham College student who has made a name for himself in the world of table tennis. He recently beat participants from 34 London Colleges to become the Association of Colleges (AoC) London Table Tennis Champion and went on to secure 6th place nationally. We caught up with him to learn more about him and his table tennis journey.



Q: WHEN DID YOU START PLAYING TABLE TENNIS, AND WHAT INSPIRED YOU TO TAKE UP THE SPORT?

A: I started playing table tennis when I was six years old. My dad was a big fan of the sport, and he used to take me to watch local tournaments. I was fascinated by the speed and agility of the players, and I knew I wanted to try it for myself.

Q: CAN YOU DESCRIBE YOUR TRAINING ROUTINE AND HOW YOU PREPARE FOR COMPETITIONS?

A: I train six days a week, usually in the evenings after school. I spend about two hours each day practicing my strokes, footwork, and serve. I also do a lot of physical training, including running, strength training, and agility drills. Before a competition, I try to get as much rest as possible and focus on my mental preparation. I visualize myself playing well and winning matches.

Q: WHAT COMPETITIONS HAVE YOU PARTICIPATED IN, AND HOW HAVE YOU PERFORMED?

A: I've participated in several local and regional tournaments, and I've also represented my school in national competitions. I've had some great performances, including winning the under-12s category at a local tournament and finishing in the top 10 at a national competition. I've also had some tough losses, but I always try to learn from them and come back stronger.

Q: WHAT ARE YOUR ASPIRATIONS FOR THE FUTURE IN TABLE TENNIS?

A: My ultimate goal is to represent my country in international competitions and maybe even the Olympics one day. I know it will take a lot of hard work and dedication, but I'm willing to put in the effort. In the short term, I want to continue improving my skills and winning more tournaments.

Q: WHAT ADVICE WOULD YOU GIVE TO SOMEONE WHO IS JUST STARTING TO PLAY TABLE TENNIS?

A: My advice would be to have fun and enjoy the sport. Table tennis is a great way to stay active and make new friends. Don't be afraid to make mistakes and keep practicing. With hard work and dedication, anyone can improve their skills and become a great player.

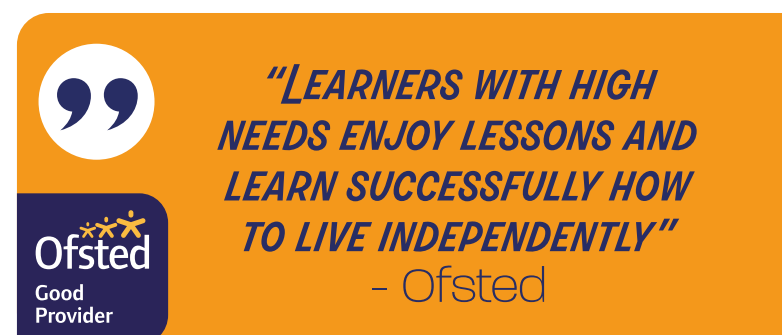

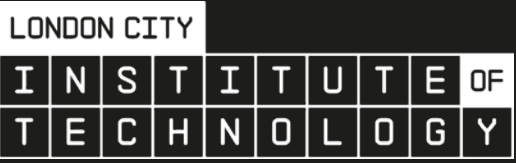

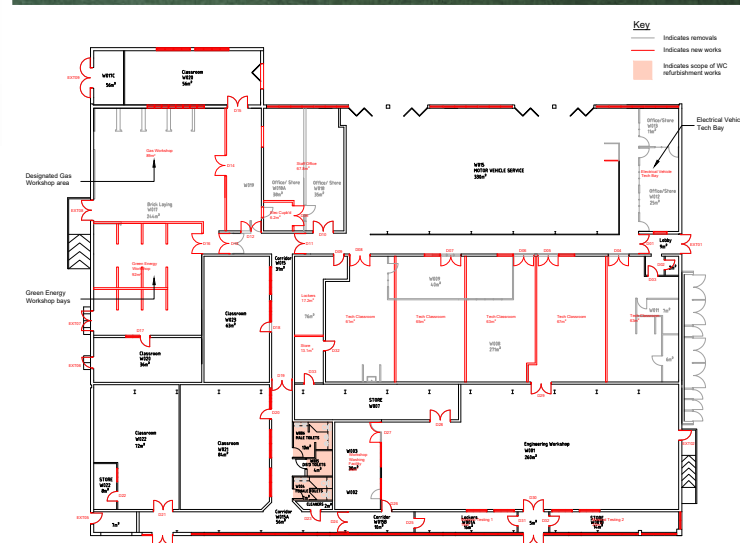
