We are excited to update our residents on the latest improvements at Newham College. The approval of a major update for a building at our Stratford Welfare Road campus means new facilities with industry-standard teaching resources, landscaped outdoor areas, and green energy efficiency.

Our Stratford campus already boasts excellent facilities, including workshops for Green Energy, Gas Engineering, Motor Vehicle, and Engineering. We have remodelled the entrance and reception, introduced Tech Teaching Suites and additional classrooms, and enhanced the learning experience for our students.

The completion of the window updating project at the East Ham Campus, covering 8 floors, is a significant milestone.

We have also upgraded specialist teaching spaces, digital facilities, and modernised classrooms throughout the campus.

Looking ahead, we have exciting plans for a front-facing hair and beauty salon, a pop-up shop to compliment the New Beans Café, which is now open to the public (see page 11), and expanded student spaces, including the cafeteria, common room, and student services area.
